



# EJCCA CLUB LEAGUE CONDENSED BYE – LAWS 2012/2013

All club officials, players, coaches, managers and parents are to acquaint themselves with the EJCCA CLUB LEAGUE BYE-LAWS, DISCIPLINARY CODE and PENALTIES, a lack of knowledge of these will not absolve any person or club of liability, responsibility or consequence.

# Application of the laws of EJCCA CRICKET league:

- No mankat
- No LBW for under 8 and u10 age groups
- Development Clubs players may be 1 (one0 year older in the Super league
- All players must be registered with their club.
- Home teams to ensure fields are correctly marked, boundaries set and stumps provided.

#### TEAM:

Maximum of 12 players, not less than 9 players. 12<sup>th</sup> man may not bat.

Maximum of 11 players-fielding side

Each team to supply scorer and umpire and own drinks

Cricket balls – Only EC approved balls to be used.

## **Dress code:**

All players to play in white/ cream cricket clothing, ie

Cricket: shirt; shorts/ longs; white socks and shoes.

Only advertising content approved by the EJCCA executive is allowed to be displayed.

Player protection: All players to wear the appropriate protective cricket equipment.

Wearing of helmets:

- Any fielder within 3 meters of batsman on strike
- Wicket keeper when standing up at the wicket
- All batsman for duration of their innings. A batsman who refuses to wear a helmet will not be permitted to bat.

## Hours of play:

Saturday mornings- Start at 8:30.

Night games- Start 6pm

Should drinks be requested, players may not leave the field and a maximum of 5 min allowed.

### Late arrivals:

A team with less than nine players present on the field at 09h00 will be deemed to have lost the match. This will constitute a no show. The game must still take place as a friendly. Two no shows – team will be withdrawn from the league for the remainder of the season.

### Shorten/incomplete/abandoned matches:

Prior to start of game where there is a possibility of the game not being completed due to weather or light, one of the following actions shall take place;

Team managers shall agree to shorten game by limiting overs;

Team managers agree to abandon game

Team managers shall continue as per the permitted overs.





When shortening game – minimum of 15 overs to be agreed to.

Bowling quotas will be reduced to 1/5 of allotted overs

Matches abandoned/incomplete due to weather or light shall be recorded as a draw.

No games may be cancelled

Should the overs be reduced after start of match, bowler individual allocations shall not be altered.

## Spin bowler requirements:

U10 – u12 age: four overs of spin before end of twentieth over

U14 – u16 age: five overs of spin before end of twenty fourth over

## The over:

U8 Age – maximum of 6 ball over

All other age groups – maximum of 8 ball over.

All wide and no balls to be counted as extras.

#### The wide ball:

No Standard Bank bye –law.

Agreement to be reached by managers and coaches prior to start, and decision to be consistently applied. Wide ball diagram in EJCCA BYE – LAWS book

#### **NO BALL:**

- Ball bounces three times or more before reaching the batsman
- Rolls along ground
- Full pitch ball which may deem to pass above strikers waist whilst standing upright
- U8 u12 age where ball bounces above shoulder height
- Beamer bowled. First warned second offence then bowler not permitted to bowl
- Maximum of one bouncer per over allowed at u14 u16 ages
- In addition to the penalty run for a no ball, any other runs shall be scored as runs to the batsman

#### Fieldsman-restrictions

No fielders may be within a 15 meter area around the batting strip in the under 8 age group.

Number of onside fielders – not exceed five fielders of whom not more than two may be behind the popping crease. Infringement shall be called a no ball

There are no power plays in the Summer EJCCA league.
